Important Instructions to Candidates (JoSAA / CSAB) allotted to NIFTEM-T

Candidates who have been allotted a seat at the National Institute of Food Technology, Entrepreneurship and Management, Thanjavur (NIFTEM-T) and have confirmed their seats through JoSAA and CSAB are requested to carefully read the following instructions:

I. Admission Schedule (Online):

- a. ONLINE Reporting: All candidates who have confirmed their allotted seats are required to complete the online reporting process within the prescribed schedule.

15th August, 2026 (10:00 AM) – 17th August, 2026 (05:00 PM)

- b. PAYMENT of Balance Fee: Candidates must remit the balance fee within the stipulated deadline to complete the provisional admission process.
 1. The candidate is instructed to pay the remaining Admission Fee (**GEN/OBC: ₹29,500; SC/ST/PwD: ₹23,330**) on or before **18-08-2026, 6:00 PM**.

4. JoSAA/CSAB Physical Reporting Letter
5. Category Certificate*, if applicable (OBC-NCL, SC, ST, or EWS certificate)
6. PwD Certificate, if applicable (UDID card or PWD-IDC).
7. Transfer Certificate.
8. Conduct Certificate.
9. Annual Income Certificate*
10. Aadhaar Card.
11. Medical Fitness Certificate (From a Certified Government Doctor).
12. Passport-size photographs with a white background (3 Nos.).
13. Admission Fee Payment Proof.

Note: *Annual Income certificate, OBC-NCL or GEN-EWS certificates must be issued on or after **01st April 2026**.

The following duly filled and signed forms to be submitted on the day of reporting

1. The Academic Rules and Regulations form. (Refer attachment)
2. Student's Personal Details form. (Refer attachment)

Additional Instructions,

- Decent formal attire is permitted within the institute and classes. Formal shoes are recommended.
