GUIDELINES FOR VARIOUS STUDENT COMPETITIONS/EVENTS



A. Poem Writing/Song Composition

- Individual event.
- Theme will be given on spot.
- Duration: 2 hours.
- Language: English/Hindi/Tamil.
- The poem/song can be written in any style.
- The poem/song must be an original work of the participant. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.
- Poems/songs containing language that is vulgar, offensive, or wholly inappropriate will be rejected.
- Poems/songs will be judged based on: poetic technique, effectiveness, reach, style, and creativity.
- Electronic devices are not allowed during the event.
- The poem/song must have around 10-15 lines excluding the title of the poem.
- The decision of the jury will be final.

B. Drawing/Collage-making

- Duration - 2 hours.
- Maximum 3 members in a team.
- Theme will be given on spot.
- For collage, any range of safe material can be used.
- For drawing and collage-making, teams must bring their own materials.
- Base chart (white) of A2 size will be provided for the team, for drawing/collage.
- For drawings, colours must be used.
- Electronic devices are not allowed during the event.
- Reference materials are not allowed during the event.
- No vulgarity allowed; if found, team will be disqualified.
- Judging will be based on creativity, clarity of idea, originality and relevance to theme.
- The decision of the jury will be final.

C. Video making

- Theme: Promoting food safety
- Duration: 2- 3 minutes
- Teams are expected to bring their final edited video in a pen drive to the event venue on 07.06.2024.
- Maximum 4 members in a team.
- No vulgarity allowed; if found, team will be disqualified.
- Plagiarised content will score less.
- Language: English/Hindi/Tamil. If other Indian languages are used, English sub-titles must be included.
- Landscape setting. Videos can be captured using mobile phones or DSLRs, etc.
- File format: MP4.
- Judging will be based on creativity, originality, performances and editing and relevance to theme.
- The decision of the jury will be final.

- Preliminary round (Off-stage; written; 60 min).

- Electronic devices are not allowed during the event.
