Participant Instruction Manual

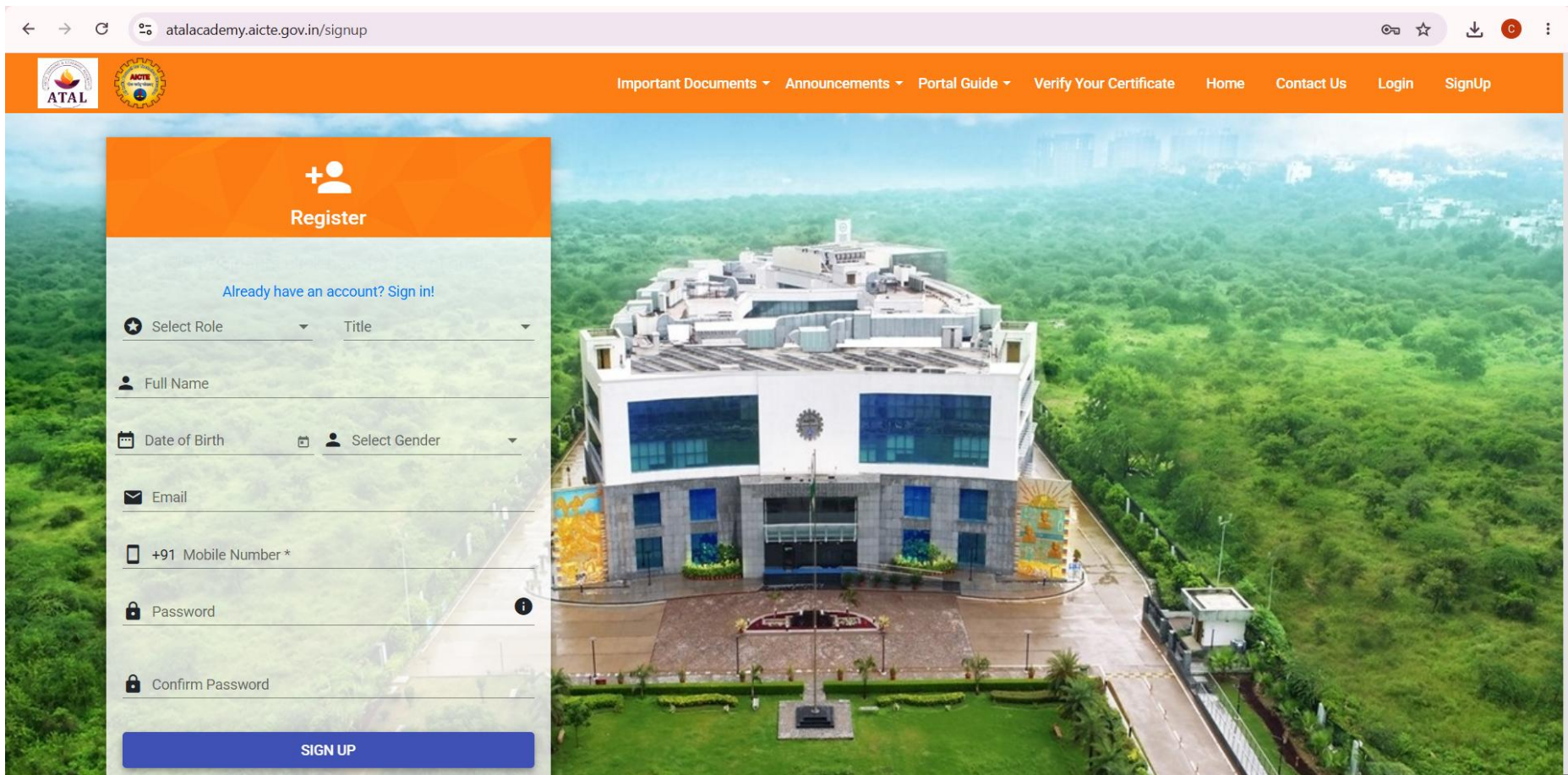
Before you begin

- Use a valid email address and mobile number.
- Keep your institutional Identity Card ready for uploading (portal shows a 2 MB limit).
- Download the prescribed AICTE VAANI NOC, complete it and obtain institutional authorization before applying.
- Enter your own correct participant and institutional details. The screenshots contain sample details only.
- After your application is approved by the programme Coordinator, the portal states that it cannot be cancelled.

Portal labels and screen layout may change slightly with future updates.

Step 1. Open the AICTE ATAL Academy portal and create an account

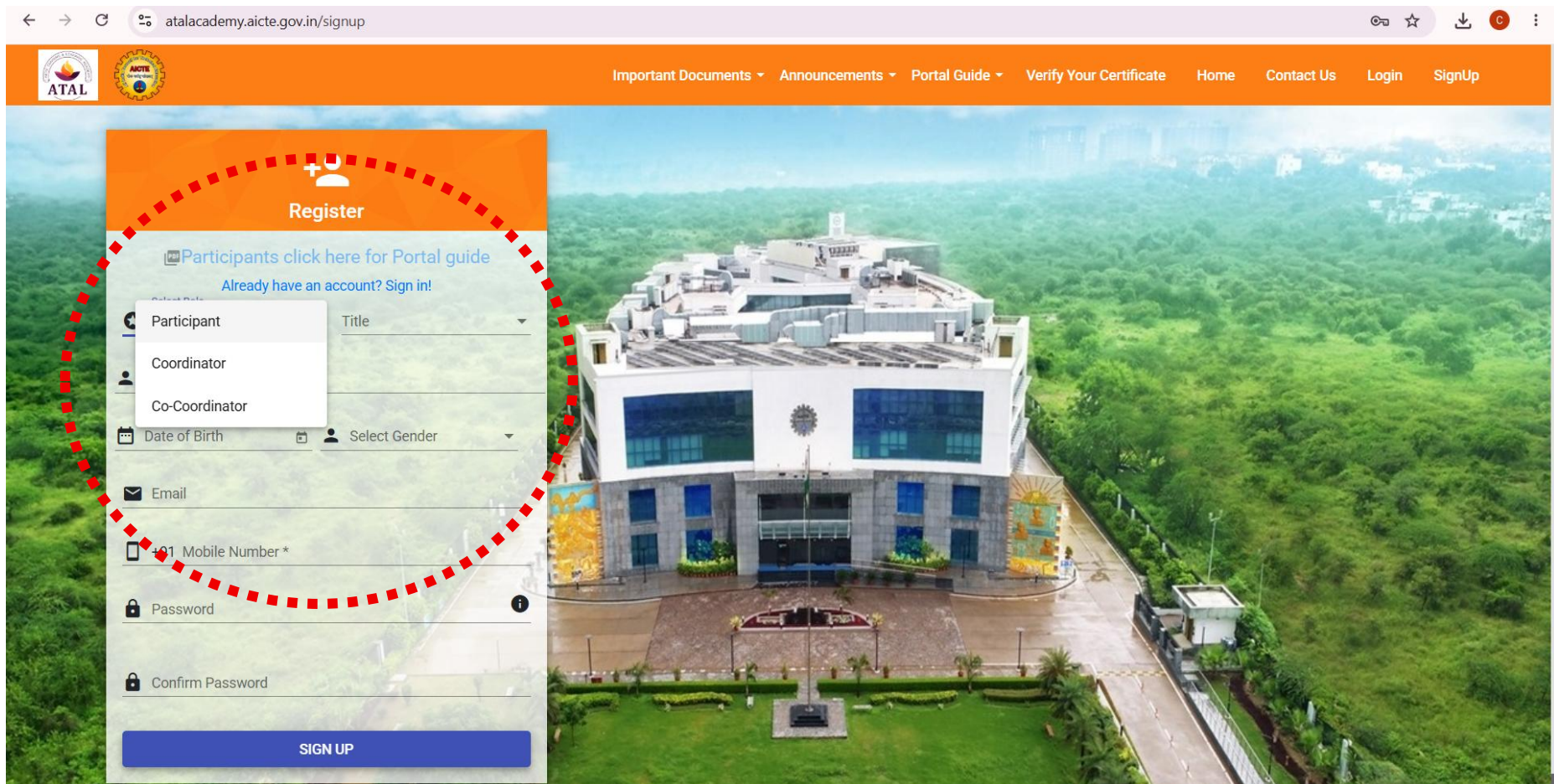
- Open the AICTE ATAL Academy registration page and click Sign Up if you do not already have an account.

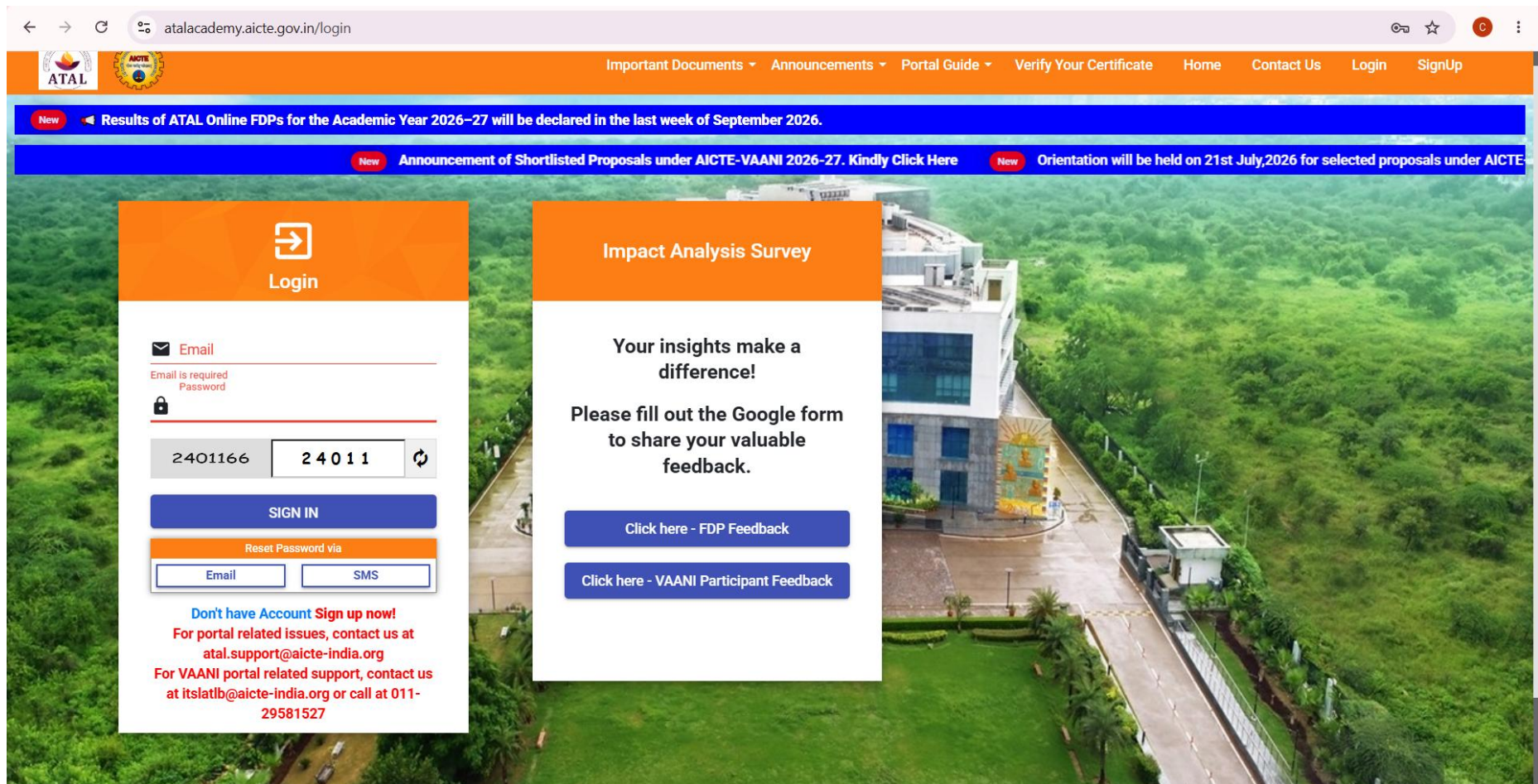

- Enter the displayed CAPTCHA correctly and click SIGN IN.



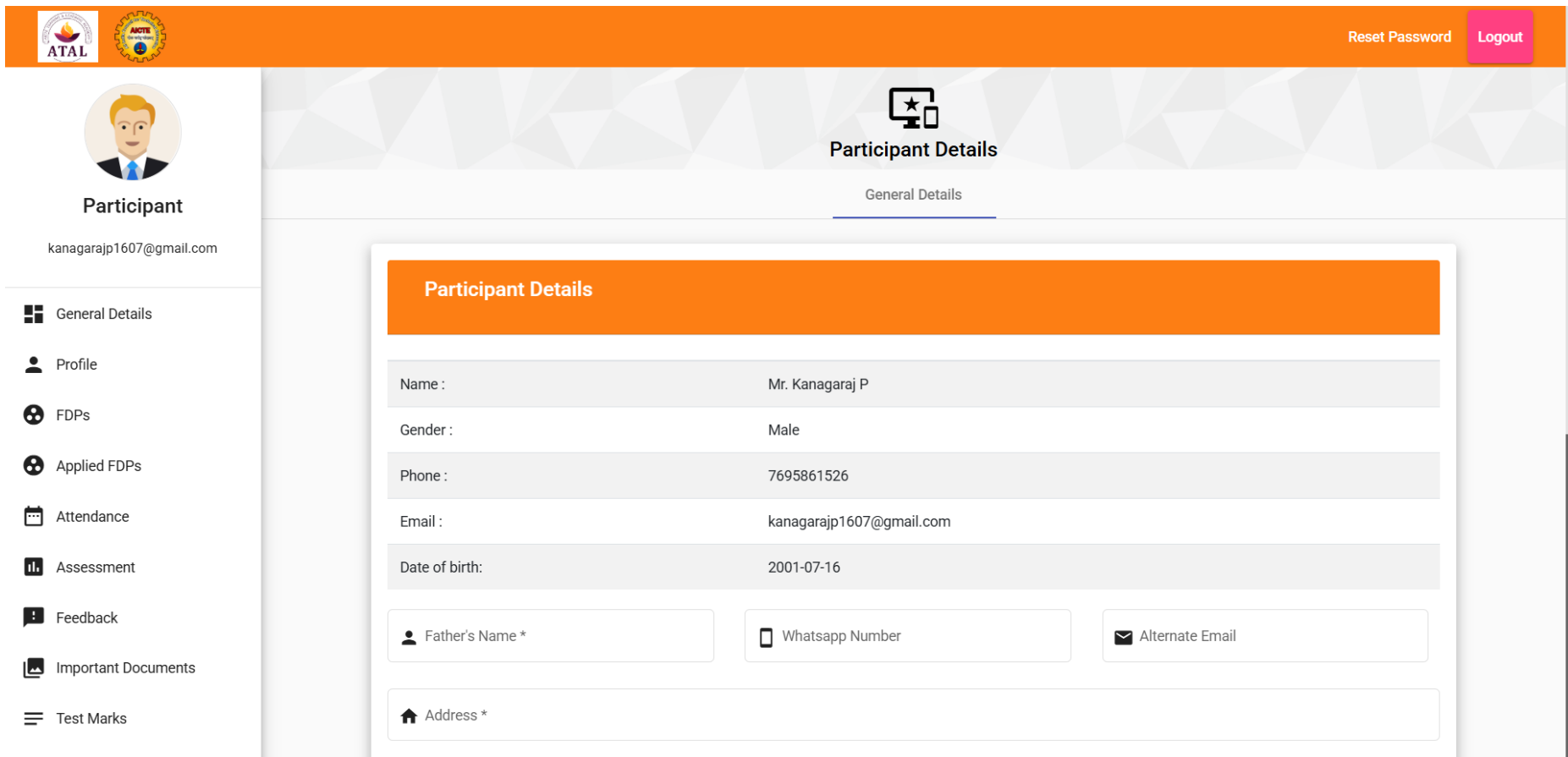
